As a key part of this engagement, Formtek implemented methods to record the time spent per workflow task (using data lists) and to associate in-process and completed requests with their workflow history, including a record of all documents used in the process. Planned enhancements to the solution will include automation of other OCALI workflow processes within Alfresco.
